All teams arriving at the airport will be met by volunteers, who

will guide them to the hotels by train.



Foreign teams living at the Zleep Hotel Copenhagen Arena (Finland and Norway) will receive a City Pass, a 72-hour ticket for all public transport within Copenhagen.

Meals

Breakfast

Breakfast will be served at the hotels between 9-11 (Saturday) and 8.30-11 (Sunday).

NB.: Breakfast restaurants are open 7.30-11.00, but due to many events in Copenhagen (eg. Copenhagen Fashion Week) the hotels are full booked, and most other guest are using the early part of the opening hours for breakfast.

Introductions All participants will be lined up and introduced individually

before the start of each event.

Seeding principles As the Match is organized on a six-lane stadium, 200m, 400m and 400m hurdles are organized over two finals. As stated in the Nordic Handbook, the following procedure will be used in

compiling the A- and B-finals:

 First, the three fastest runners according to the ongoing year's statistics are put into the A-final. (-> Now there are

representatives of 2 or 3 teams in A-final.)

 Then, the A-final is completed by adding, according to current statistics, the best runner(s) of the remaining team(s). Thus the A-final consists of 4 or 5 runners and

covers all the four teams.

 Finally, each team has the right to change places of their own runners between the finals, if they wish so. (The change

needs to be done in the call room).

TRANSPORT

For teams moving between the airport (B), Tårnby Stadion (green circle) and Zleep Hotel Copenhagen Arena (A) the easiest way is to use the train. They are all on the same line and there are no stops in between.



Trains depart approximately every 15 minutes, and the travel time between the stations is:
Airport -> Tårnby Station: 3 minutes
Airport -> Ørestad Station: 5-6 minutes
Ørestad Station -> Tårnby Station: 2-3 minutes

Zleep Hotel Arena, Ørestad Station and Dalle Valle (the dinner restaurant) are all located in the same area with following distances: Ørestad Station -> Zleep Hotel Arena: 350m Ørestad Station -> Dalle Valle: 250m Zleep Hotel Arena -> Dalle Valle: 600m
