Date: 13/6 - 14/6 2026

Location: Jessheim, NOR

Athlete Contribution – DKK 6500 + Flights to be self-booked

Date of selection: 1st June 2026

ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION

In addition to meeting the General Eligibility Requirements in Appendix 1, to be eligible for consideration for selection, athletes must achieve standards set out below.

QUALIFICATION

To be considered for selection, athletes must meet the below standards for their corresponding event:

| Women's Heptathlon | Age Group | Men's Decathlon |
|--------------------|-----------|-----------------|
| 5000 points | SEN | 7000 points |
| 4600 points | U20 | 6500 points |
| 4400 points | U18 | 6100 points |

SELECTION PROCESS

The Selection Panel (the "Selection Panel") will select from athletes who meet the General Eligibility Criteria and Performance Requirements.

In addition to the result requirements, in special cases a sporting overall assessment can be made based on:

- o Performance level in individual disciplines (assuming there has been no opportunity to participate in/conduct a Combined Event competition)
- o Previous level in Combined Event competition (primarily the 2025 season)
- o Previous performances in an international context
- o Future potential in relevant age groups



In its assessment of an athlete, or where Danish Athletics does not have the capacity or appropriate resources to provide the level of health-related support required, the Selection Panel may decide not to select an athlete if Danish Athletics' medical advice considers that participation would pose a risk to the athlete's health or the safety of others.

The Selection Panel will include conditions regarding form, fitness and health-related assessment. In the event the athlete fails to comply with the conditions, the provisions for deselection as set out below may apply.

SELECTION PANEL

1. Selections will be made by the Danish Athletics selection panel comprising:

- Danish Athletics Sportschef (voting)
- Danish Athletics Event Group Leads for
 - Combined Events (voting)

The Chair of the Panel may also (at his/her discretion) seek assistance (in a non-voting capacity) from anyone else he/she feels may be of help.

DE-SELECTION

Following selection, an athlete may be de-selected by the Selection Panel or Danish Athletics in the event of:

- The athlete ceasing to comply with the eligibility criteria set out in this Selection Policy, or other strategy document or policy communicated by Danish Athletics.
- Failure to agree to the Code of Conduct or Team Member Agreement.
- Failure to comply with any conditions set by the Selection Panel.
- The athlete not complying with any selection conditions set by Danish Athletics.
- Any anti-doping rule violation or provisional suspension or failure to complete any required antidoping action, including training or courses.
- Any serious misconduct or suspension due to misconduct.
- A breach of any Danish Athletics policy.
- Danish Athletics reasonably considering that the athlete will be unable to perform at the level required or expected due to any reason including loss of form or failure to recover fully or as expected from injury or illness
- Failure to opt-in to team training or events



GENERAL PROVISIONS

Danish Athletics reserves the right to amend this Selection Policy at any time in its sole discretion and will make any amended version publicly available (including the date on which any amendment was made)

APPENDIX 1 – GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Be eligible to compete for Denmark and be the holder of a full and current Danish passport.
2. Comply with all World Athletics and competition rules relevant to the category and/or event they wish to compete in.
3. Is not serving a period of ineligibility from the sport (as determined by Danish Athletics) or from any other sport. For example, due to misconduct and/or disciplinary reasons.
4. Not under investigation or been charged by Danish Athletics or any other relevant organisation with misconduct or any disciplinary, safeguarding or criminal offence.
5. Completed all anti-doping requirements.
6. Not committed a criminal, disciplinary or safeguarding offence that in the reasonable opinion of the Board of Danish Athletics renders the athlete unsuitable for selection.
7. Has not, whether by an act or omission, brought Danish Athletics into disrepute.
